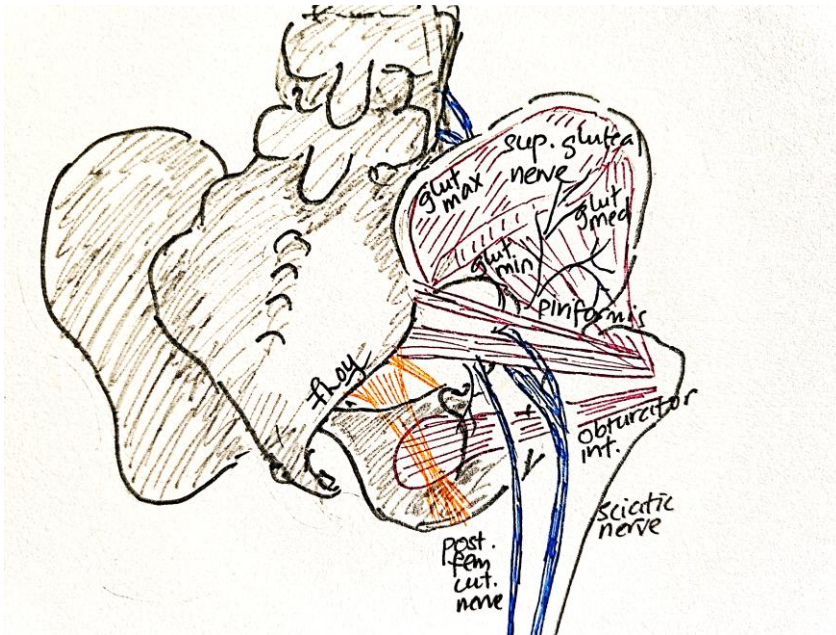

Intent

Lower back pain and dysfunction are one of the most common complaints physiotherapists see in their practice.

This 3 hrs session will:
